





THE GOSPEL LESSON Mark 1:29-39

 $^{29}$  As soon as they left the synagogue, they went with James and John to the home of Simon and Andrew.  $^{30}$  Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever, and they immediately told Jesus about her.  $^{31}$  So he went to her, took her hand and helped her up. The fever left her and she began to wait on them.

<sup>32</sup> That evening after sunset the people brought to Jesus all the sick and demonpossessed. <sup>33</sup> The whole town gathered at the door, <sup>34</sup> and Jesus healed many who had various diseases. He also drove out many demons, but he would not let the demons speak because they knew who he was.

<sup>35</sup> Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. <sup>36</sup> Simon and his companions went to look for him, <sup>37</sup> and when they found him, they exclaimed: "Everyone is looking for you!"



#### THE NICENE CREED






