VOTERS MEETING: The Board of Lutheran Schools recommended to the Church Council at its meeting on February 9th that we have a full-day 5K program for 2016/2017 here at St. Paul's. That would mean that the Kindergarten teacher position would go from being a part-time call to a full-time call. The Church Council agrees with this recommendation and unanimously approved taking the recommendation to the congregation at a special Voter's meeting. Therefore, the Church Council has set a Voters Meeting for February 29th at 7:30pm. (This will be the only agenda item on that evening.) If the Voters were to approve the recommendation, there would be another Voters Meeting on March 14th at 7:30pm to issue this full-time call.
