They are collecting funds to buy a full house generator to energize the headquarters of the Central Africa Medical Mission (CAMM) and buy water-purifying supplies for Indonesia. There is a tremendous need for purified water and to get a constant supply of electricity to the CAMM headquarters where many vaccines are kept that need refrigeration. The goal of this project is \$25,000. *We collected \$342.15 for our 3rd Quarter Mission, the LWMS Kids C.A.R.E. project.
