**BOX TOPS:** Congratulations to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade for winning the March Box Tops! They brought in 19.5 per student, 6<sup>th</sup> grade was in 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 11.3 each, and Kindergarten was in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 5.3 each. Church members turned in 90 for a grand total for the month of 1,043 and 8,045 for the year. We are getting close to our goal of 10,000. So far for April, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grade are in the lead with 30.9 each, 5<sup>th</sup> grade is in 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade is in 3<sup>rd</sup>. **FOURTH QUARTER MISSION OFFERING:** We will be supporting Wisconsin Lutheran High School's "Our Hands for His Service" program this quarter. This year's project is "Generating Pure Love". They are collecting funds to buy a full house generator to energize the headquarters of the Central Africa Medical Mission (CAMM) and buy water-purifying supplies for Indonesia. There is a tremendous need for purified water and to get a constant supply of electricity to the CAMM headquarters where many vaccines are kept that need refrigeration. The goal of this project is \$25,000.
