**FOURTH QUARTER MISSION PROJECT:** Our 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Mission project will be WLHS' Our Hands For His Service project. This year, OHFHS hopes to raise \$30,000 for a ministry named "Taste of Ethiopia" whose mission is taken from James 1:27 that reads in part ". . . look after orphans and widows." At present, Taste of Ethiopia operates a fully licensed portable kitchen (truck) in Green Bay where they bring authentic Ethiopian food to farmers markets, weddings, and a variety of other events. Rave reviews are mounting. The rolling restaurant is a non-profit with all proceeds going to improve life for Ethiopian orphans with education, substantial food, and the gospel. Why Ethiopia? That's the home country of Tesfaye Joyce, one of the ministry team of three and a WLC graduate. The next phase of their mission is to put a truck in Ethiopia itself.
