CLOSING WORSHIP SERVICE: Our school year closing worship service will be on Thursday at 10:30 AM. Parents are welcome to attend!

LAST DAY OF SCHOOL – HALF DAY: The last day of school is this Thursday, May 31st. Please have your child bring in an extra bag or two to carry home all of their supplies. Preschool students will be dismissed at their usual time of 11:15 AM. K5-Grade 8 students will be dismissed at noon.

SCHOOL PICNIC: There will be a school picnic following our noon dismissal on Thursday, May 31st at Lion's Legend Park on Drexel (the newer area just east of the Fire Department). It is east of Loomis Avenue on the south side of Drexel Avenue. The teachers are not in charge of this event, so all children going to the park must have an adult chaperone. If you are not able to bring your child and would like him/her to attend, please arrange for another parent to be in charge. Also, please bring your own lunch. There is playground equipment, as well as tennis courts and a baseball diamond.

8TH GRADE GRADUATION: Our Graduation service is this Thursday, May 31st at 6:30 PM. Kindergarten – Grade 8 sing and all families are expected to attend. Students should meet in their classrooms at 6:15 PM but not earlier than 6:00 PM. Report cards will be handed out after the service. UPPER GIRLS & BOYS BATHROOM REMODEL PROJECT FOR THE SUMMER OF 2018: We have a handful of volunteers ready to donate their time this summer to renovate the upper classroom bathrooms and are asking for financial support to fund this project. This remodel project would consist of:

- Redoing floor (gray epoxy) with wall base.
- New Bathroom stalls (solid black plastic) with new tissue dispensers.
- New hardware and plumbing for toilets, urinals and sinks.
- Updated lighting along with a coat of paint.

The Board of Buildings & Grounds is projecting a budgetary cost of \$8,000 to cover the material cost of this project.
