PRE-K GRADUATION AND PLAY: Our preschoolers will be graduating and performing their play tomorrow, Wednesday, May 31st at 6:30 PM. Please come and join us for this fun evening!

K-8 LAST DAY OF SCHOOL: The last day of school for Grades K-8 is this Thursday, June 1st. There will be a closing service at 11:30 AM that day, and all are welcome to attend. Please have your child bring in an extra bag to carry home all of their supplies. Students will be dismissed at noon. There is no school on Friday – Graduation is at 6:30 PM.

SCHOOL PICNIC: There will be a school picnic at the end of classes on Thursday, May 26th at Lion's Legend Park on Drexel (the newer area just east of the Fire Department). It is east of Loomis Avenue on the south side of Drexel Avenue. The teachers are not in charge of this, so all children going to the park must have an adult chaperone.
