**SCHOOL CHOICE INFORMATIONAL MEETING: Sunday, November 10<sup>th</sup>,** between church services (9:15-10:15) we will be holding an informational meeting about the Wisconsin School Choice Program. Mr. Terry Brown (the Vice President of School Choice Wisconsin) and Dr. Ken Fischer (the President of Wisconsin Lutheran High School) will be joining us to talk about the basics of the School Choice Wisconsin program. The Board of Lutheran Schools and the Church Council are currently looking into the benefits and challenges we would face if we were to become a choice school. This informational meeting is just that - informational. Please come ready to listen, learn, and ask questions as we carefully look at the opportunity the choice program may offer to help us fulfill our mission of "reaching out to the people of the world through worship and **education** by living and sharing the gospel of Christ."

**SECOND QUARTER MISSION PROJECT – HUNGER TASK FORCE FARM:** Our 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter mission project is underway – the Hunger Task Force Farm. The Farm is a unique 208 acre urban farm right here in Franklin. During the growing season, The Farm infuses half a million pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables into their food bank’s supply. More than 25 different varieties of produce is grown each season to feed children, seniors and families in our community. Our mission offerings this quarter will support The Farm’s Adopt-A-Crop program: \$25 supplies a bushel of sweet corn to a local food pantry, \$50 provides 40 pounds of green beans to local seniors, \$100 grows 100 heads of lettuce for local families in need and \$250 sponsors an acre’s worth of broccoli seed!

Gary Eickhorst and Southside Ministries will use these as Christmas gifts for immigrant children. Thank you for your support of Southside Ministries.
