SECOND QUARTER MISSION PROJECT – APACHE MISSION: The Apache Mission celebrated 125 years of God's blessings in 2018 as the first world mission of WELS. The Apache Mission is located in eastern Arizona on the Fort Apache Reservation and the San Carlos Apache Reservation. Between the two reservations there are eight churches, one preaching station, and two Lutheran elementary schools. The Apache Lutheran churches are currently training future leaders for work as evangelists, teachers, and pastors through the Apache Christian Training School (ACTS) located at the East Fork Mission. Your gift will support theological education through the Apache Christian Training School, outreach to new Native American tribes, property repairs and renovations, and general school and ministry expenses.
