WELCOME BACK! Hope everyone had a fun, healthy summer and is ready for a great year of learning!

MONDAY MESSENGER: The Monday Messenger is our weekly newsletter that keeps you up to date on all things St. Paul's! The Monday Messenger is e-mailed each Monday – usually late morning. It is also available on our website: stpaulsfranklin.org. Some items will still come home in paper form so please check your child's backpack each Monday. **If your family prefers to receive a paper copy, please let Cory in the office know as soon as possible.**

MORNING ARRIVAL PROCEDURES: Students in K5 – Grade 8 arriving before 7:45 AM should report to Mrs. Willms' 4K classroom for before school care. 3K and 4K students will be in Mrs. Tripoli's 3K room. Students arriving after 7:45 AM can report directly to their classrooms.

SCHOOL DISMISSAL: At 3K and 4K dismissal, students will be walked out of the front doors at 11:45 AM. At 3:15, all other grades will be brought outside. K-2 will be located near the main entrance to the school. Grades 3-8 will be dismissed through the north doors near the dumpsters. Parents picking up students from after school care may come into the building to sign their children out. Thank you for your patience as we navigate this new dismissal procedure.

PARKING LOT: For the safety of our children please enter and leave the parking lot slowly. Also a reminder that there is no parking at any time in the designated fire lane along the entrance to the school.

VISITOR SIGN IN PROCEDURE: Any parents and/or visitors in the building during normal school hours must sign in on the log in the office. This does not include regular drop off and pick up times. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our school safe!

FIRST QUARTER MISSION PROJECT – AFRICAN MEDICAL MISSION: Each quarter we focus on one project for our mission offerings. This quarter's mission focus is to support the African Medical Mission. This mission serves as the supportive branch to the gospel mission by communicating Christ's love and by caring concern for the physical needs of our fellow man. The Lutheran Mission Rural Health Centre has been serving the people of Zambia since 1961 and The Lutheran Mobile Clinic the people of Malawi since 1970. These clinics provide preventative health care for children and expectant women as well as treatment of patients with illnesses such as malaria, HIV/AIDS, parasitic infections and tuberculosis. Together, the clinics in Zambia and Malawi serve over 80,000 patients a year. Each clinic day begins with devotion so that all in attendance can hear the Good News of their Savior. ***The mission envelope that comes home each week can be used for your offerings! Students should return the envelopes to their classroom mission offering baskets.**
