FIRST QUARTER MISSION PROJECT – AFRICAN MEDICAL MISSION: This quarter's mission focus is to support the African Medical Mission. This mission serves as the supportive branch to the gospel mission by communicating Christ's love and by caring concern for the physical needs of our fellow man. The Lutheran Mission Rural Health Centre has been serving the people of Zambia since 1961 and The Lutheran Mobile Clinic the people of Malawi since 1970. These clinics provide preventative health care for children and expectant women as well as treatment of patients with illnesses such as malaria, HIV/AIDS, parasitic infections and tuberculosis. Together, the clinics in Zambia and Malawi serve over 80,000 patients a year. Each clinic day begins with devotion so that all in attendance can hear the Good News of their Savior.
